Hamilton, ON - April 1, 2023 - Medical Laboratory Week in Ontario will be celebrated April 9-15th, 2023. This year's campaign theme for Ontario is "Labs Save Lives". The intent is to showcase and celebrate the essential but often unseen work performed by labs and bring the stories of the lives saved by these heroes to the forefront. The Medical Laboratory Professionals' Association of Ontario (MLPAO) hopes to educate the government, media, allied healthcare partners, and the public that the services provided by our laboratories save the lives of those you love.

The pandemic taught us many things, one of which is how important our lab professionals are to the overall success of our healthcare system. Lab professionals have processed over 840+ million tests and 26+ million COVID-19 tests over the past three years and this life-saving work has been performed by a group who were severely understaffed prior to the pandemic.
