Public Transit Options

By TTC (Toronto Transit Commission)

- Take Line 1 (Yonge-University Subway)
- Exit at Union Station
- Walk south along Bay Street toward Queens Quay
- Walking Time to Venue: Approximately 10–15 minutes

By Streetcar

- Take the 509 Harbourfront or 510 Spadina streetcar
- Exit at Queens Quay Ferry Docks Terminal
- Walking Time to Venue: Approximately 3–5 minutes

Regional Transit (GO Transit & VIA Rail)

- Arrive at Union Station via GO Transit or VIA Rail
- Walk or connect to TTC streetcar service to Queens Quay
- Taxi and rideshare pickup areas are available at Union Station



Airport Travel

From Toronto Pearson International Airport

- **Taxi/Rideshare:** Approx. 35–50 minutes depending on traffic
- **UP Express + TTC:**
 - Take the UP Express train to Union Station
 - Walk south to the venue or transfer to the 509 Harbourfront streetcar
 - Exit at Queens Quay Ferry Docks Terminal

From Billy Bishop Toronto City Airport

- **Taxi/Rideshare:** Approx. 10–15 minutes
- **Public Transit:**
 - Take the airport shuttle toward Union Station
 - Walk or transfer to TTC streetcar service
