

## **MLPAO MLA/T and MLT Early Career Bursary**

One MLPAO bursary of \$1,500 is awarded to a recent graduate of an MLA/T or MLT program in Ontario.

### **Eligibility**

An applicant must meet the following criteria in order to be eligible:

- **certified MLA/T or registered MLT member of the MLPAO**
- employed in a clinical lab in Ontario having entered the profession within the last 2 years
- Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or landed immigrant

### **Selection Criteria**

The following criteria are considered in determining the recipient:

- The applicant demonstrates how they would benefit from the bursary including a description of how the bursary will be used to help jumpstart their career.
- The applicant demonstrates a personal commitment to the profession through leadership or significant participation in educational or community activities.
- The applicant submits a completed application form along with all the required documents by the application deadline.

### **Application Requirements**

1. Completed MLPAO Early Career Bursary Application
2. Original letter (500 – 600 words) from the applicant to the MLPAO Bursaries Selection Committee describing:
  - a. how they would benefit from the bursary including a description of how the bursary will help to jumpstart their career;
  - b. their personal commitment to the profession through leadership or significant participation in educational or community activities; and
  - c. any special circumstances to be considered by the Selection Committee.
3. Letter of employment from a clinical lab in Ontario stating dates of employment and position
4. Copy of MLPAO certification for MLA/T graduates or copy of CSMLS certificate for MLT graduates

**Deadline for application submission is February 28.**  
**Any incomplete and/or late applications will be disqualified.**
