**Position Summary:**

The Medical Laboratory Technologist (“MLT”) is responsible for performing a variety of laboratory tests, many of which are complex, involve numerous steps and techniques, and require the use of professional judgment and critical thinking skills. Professional application of the principles, laboratory theories, and techniques of medical terminology are used to produce reliable results that aid the physician in diagnosis and treatment.

- Maintenance of quality control procedures and processes
- Collects specimens from patients directly as required. Identifying, accessioning, and determining the suitability of specimens for testing
- Ensuring instrumentation is functioning properly
- Reports results to the appropriate parties under the

- Maintains knowledge in the use of and maintenance of the Laboratory testing
- Equipment maintaining a safe work environment
