In the event that you are unable to be vaccinated as a result of a ground protected under the Human Rights Code, you may submit a written explanation of the ground and any supporting documentation to determine if you are exempt from this requirement to the recruitment team. A human resources representative may follow up with you for further information if necessary.

As part of our mandatory screening process, the Hospital will require professional references, verification of academic training and professional accreditation along with a vulnerable sector screen.
